These events are specifically designed to enable critical transparency and inspection. Failure to include any of these events results in reduced transparency and is a lost opportunity to inspect and adapt." Therefore, a Sprint is over when its time-box expires, regardless of whether all Product Backlog items or tasks are completed or not.
